

New scholarships for 2022

Rewarding and supporting outstanding students



Recognising the achievements of outstanding school leavers and gap year students

- **JCU Vice Chancellor's Scholarship.** \$40,000 awarded for up to 4 years of study. For ATAR 97+. Recipients of the JCU Vice Chancellor's Scholarship will receive \$10,000 per annum for up to four years (equivalent to \$40,000)*.
- **JCU Deans' Scholarship.** \$20,000 awarded for up to 4 years of study. For ATAR 95 to 96. Recipients of the JCU Deans' Scholarship will receive \$5,000 per annum for up to four years (equivalent to \$20,000)*.

In addition to the financial support, recipients of both scholarships will have access to development and enrichment opportunities including mentoring and Continuing Professional Development.

Eligibility: Be a new JCU student, enrolling in full-time study at JCU, in an eligible bachelor's degree for Semester One, 2022. (excluding Medicine, Dentistry and Veterinary Science).

The new scholarships will be automatically assessed for new JCU students with an ATAR 95+ who are starting their studies with JCU in Semester One, 2022. Students graduating Year 12 in 2021, or who graduated in 2020 and are currently taking a gap year, may be eligible.

JCU Vice Chancellor's Scholarship*

- \$40,000 for up to 4 years of study
- For students with an ATAR 97-100.

JCU Deans' Scholarship*

- \$20,000 for up to 4 years of study
- For students with an ATAR 95-96.

► Process

- Apply to your chosen JCU undergraduate course via QTAC.
- We will assess your application for eligibility.
- If you are successful we will advise you at the time of offer.
- Offers begin after ATARs are released in December 2021.

Both the JCU Vice Chancellor's Scholarship and the JCU Deans' Scholarship are automatically assessed. If you meet the criteria you will be notified at the time of offer. There is no application required for these scholarships.
