Most institutional Open Days are held in late July and August. Institutions hold events throughout the year; follow them on social media to be advised of upcoming activities.

What happens on an Open Day?

Open Days are opportunities for institutions to profile their courses and highlight their campus facilities. You will have the opportunity to hear from and speak to academics, lecturers, current students, and information officers. You may have the chance to do some hands-on or practical activities.

Who should participate in an Open Day?

We recommend that Year 10 students participate in one Open Day this year and Year 11 and 12s one or two.

Why should you participate in an Open Day?

- You will be able to gather detailed information about courses, how they are structured, majors available, double degree options and employment outcomes.
- You are going to feel more comfortable arriving at a university or TAFE institute on the first day of classes if you have been there before or seen interactive images on-line.
- You can discover what is really involved in the course or courses you are interested in
- If necessary you can explore accommodation options.
- You will be able to get a feel of the campus -is it a bustling environment with lots of activity or a quieter, more relaxed campus set in landscaped grounds, is it centrally located or more suburban/regional.
- Discover transport options, scholarships available, opportunities for exchange, clubs and societies.....

How to make the most out of an Open Day

The most important thing is to **REGISTER** for the Open Day/s that you are interested in. A personalised program will be generated for you to help you to schedule your day. Your weekend time is precious so you want to plan and structure your day, otherwise you can miss out on relevant information or become overwhelmed. By registering you will also be able to access information after the event such as recordings of the presentations.
