OPEN DAYS 2021

Most tertiary institutions will hold an Open Day in late July or August. Some are running an in person Open Day as well as a virtual Open Day.

What happens on an Open Day?

On Open Day you can visit an institution when it's at its best. You can talk to academics, lecturers, current students and information officers about what certain courses, career outcomes, and about university life.

Who should participate in an Open Day?

Anyone who is considering studying at a tertiary level in the next few years should attend.

This year, due to restrictions, many institutions are giving Year 12 and Year 11 students priority for their on campus Open Days, so it is very important for you to register for the ones you want to attend.

Why should you attend an Open Day?

- To get the feel of a place. If you're going to spend 2, 3 or more years somewhere, you want to make sure you feel comfortable there.
- Discover the facilities on offer.
- You are going to feel more comfortable arriving at a university or TAFE institute on the first day of classes if you have done your research and found out more about the institution.
- To obtain course information.
- To find out about Scholarships, exchange opportunities and Clubs & Societies.
- To find out if you would be happier studying in a large institution or a smaller one.
- Consider how you are going to get there. Is it close to public transport or should you start saving for a car?

How to make the best of Open Days

- Write down a list of questions you would like to ask about particular courses.
- On arrival at campus, get a map so you can find your way around.
- Visit as many parts of the campus as you can.
- Take the opportunity to speak to students and staff.
- At a virtual open day, take a virtual tour.
- Before you go online, be prepared with your questions, pen and paper.
- Enjoy the experience!

Not everyone can participate in every Open Day and various institutions are also holding their Open Days on the same date, so students are encouraged to register for as many as possible so that even if you miss one, you should receive notifications from the institutions and may be sent recordings of the event.
