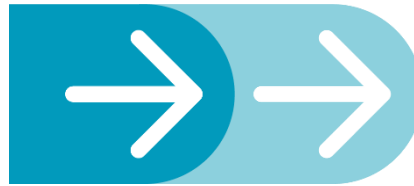

Studying a H Course in the University of Canberra's Accelerated Pathways Program will complement your ACT Year 11 and 12 College studies, giving you access to the library, computer systems, and modern learning and research facilities at UC. You'll thrive in an environment where innovation, collaboration and hands-on experience unite to expand your horizons and create a pathway to your future.

Entry to this program is by written application and interview, and is based on learner attributes and interest in the subject area. Appropriate college co-requisites apply. Students attend one-two hour class per week during ACT school term time. Classes occur on campus on Wednesday afternoons from 4:45-6:45pm.

Successful completion of a H Course will contribute to your Year 12 Senior Secondary Certificate and may form part of your ATAR calculation. Students who are successful in their H Course studies will be eligible for early entry offers into UC and will gain credit towards their university studies.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHAT IS A H COURSE?

A H course classification is a Year 11 and 12 course which is provided by an Australian higher education provider: in this case, the University of Canberra.

Successful completion of a H course can be used to meet the requirements for an ACT Senior Secondary Certificate and Tertiary Entrance Statement. The course scores you achieve in the program may contribute towards your Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) calculation. A H course is a BSSS Minor.

### WHY STUDY IN THE ACCELERATED PATHWAYS PROGRAM AT UC?

This program will give you the opportunity to study on campus at the University of Canberra and access the library, computer systems and facilities. Completion of this course will be credited toward your ACT Senior Secondary Certificate and can be used in the calculation of your ATAR.

Students who successfully undertake studies in the Accelerated Pathways Program can receive conditional early entry offers into UC, as well as earn credit towards their studies at UC in the subject areas completed.

### CAN I APPLY FOR MORE THAN ONE COURSE?

Yes. You may choose to apply for more than one course area that compliments what you are studying at your home college. Appropriate co-requisites apply.

Students wishing to apply for more than one course area must complete a separate Student Application Form for each course. For example: one application for Psychology and one application for Anatomy and Physiology. Please note that only one College Recommendation is required. Applicants should state their course preference when submitting their application as a placement will only be offered in one course area.

### WHEN AND WHERE ARE CLASSES HELD?

All classes are held on Wednesday afternoons on UC campus (Bruce) for 2 hours: 4:45pm to 6:45pm. The program is delivered during ACT Public School Terms 2-4 of Year 11, and continues in Terms 1-3 of Year 12.

### HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

This program is free to students. Any subsequent studies undertaken at UC after the completion of Year 12 will be subject to the relevant fees.

### WHAT IS THE APPLICATION PROCESS?

There are two parts to the written application process. Applicants are required to submit a Student Application that includes a Learner Reflection Statement and a H Course Selection Statement. A representative from your home college will also need to complete the College Recommendation section of the form. Once applications have closed, all applicants will be sent a link to complete an online one-way interview.

Applications for 2022 open in November this year and close in Term 1, 2022.
