



Please join us as, our St Paul's Chapel Choir and Chamber Orchestra delight us with their music and as we hear of the Jesus story which changed the world.



E-Safety Update - Changes Coming!





From 10 December 2025, social media platforms must restrict users under the age of 16. Self-declared birthdates will no longer be trusted; age will be inferred from device and account data.

- Young people may lose access or need ID verification of their age to continue to have access
- Posting, liking, and messaging may be blocked

For parishes with children and youth ministries, please consider how these changes may impact how you communicate with the young people who attend.

How can we help young people prepare for these changes?

Encourage young people to:

- Save important content including photos and memories from existing accounts.
- Swap phone numbers with family and friends.
- Cancel paid subscriptions.
- Beware of scams offering to restore accounts.


