



### Contemplative Evening Prayer for St Teresa of Avila







## National Police Clearance - Approved Providers

If you or your volunteers need a National Police Certificate and prefer to apply individually and self-fund, rather than make use of the service provided by the Safe Ministry team, you can check authorised bodies via the Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission website at <https://www.acic.gov.au/accredited-bodies>

## Working with Children Checks

**Important Note:** There are penalties for providing misleading information to the Working with Children Screening Unit – this includes fines for approving someone who is not engaged in child related work.

Please do not approve a Working with Children application if the person is not in a role that requires a WWC Check in the Diocese of Perth. If in doubt, please contact the Safe Ministry Team.
