


Contemplative Evening Prayer for St Teresa of Avila Wednesday 15 October 2025 6.30pm - free entry

Please join us as we celebrate her life in prayer, silence, meditation and hearing her words.




κοινωνία Catholic Fellowship in the Anglican Diocese of Perth

A gathering of those in the catholic tradition for prayer, worship and learning.

Clergy gatherings occur every two months, with a discussion topic chosen by the host. Topics so far have included Marian devotion, Holy Week liturgies and sacramental evangelism. We begin by praying the rosary, followed by Mass, then discuss the day's topic over a shared meal.

Particular feasts are chosen each year for public worship at various churches, bringing the catholic tradition to life in this place.

National Police Clearance - Approved Providers

If you or your volunteers need a National Police Certificate and prefer to apply individually and self-fund, rather than make use of the service provided by the Safe Ministry team, you can check authorised bodies via the Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission website at https://www.acic.gov.au/accredited-bodies

Important Note: There are penalties for providing misleading information to the Working with Children Screening Unit – this includes fines for approving someone who is not engaged in child related work.

Please do not approve a Working with Children application if the person is not in a role that requires a WWC Check in the Diocese of Perth. If in doubt, please contact the Safe Ministry Team.


