SAFE MINISTRY UPDATE

📌 **Reminder – VNPC (Criminal Check) ID Requirements**

When you submit your VNPC application, make sure to include **THREE (3) types of ID**:

- 1 Commencement document (e.g. passport (current) / birth certificate)
- 1 Primary document (e.g. driver's licence)
- 1 Secondary document (e.g. Medicare card / government issued ID card)

📄 You can find a list of acceptable ID types on Page 2 of the application form.

🔄 **Important note:** If you're using your birth certificate but your last name has changed, you'll also need to provide a marriage or change-of-name certificate issued by the Registrar to match your ID documents.

💡 **Easiest option?** Submit copies of your current passport, driver's licence, and Medicare card - it's simple and usually covers all the requirements.

🌿 **_Opening Discussion Prompt for Parish Councils - Tips for Safe Ministry agenda item**

In accordance with Policy 40 Safe Ministry and Professional Standards Framework, Safe Ministry is to be a standing agenda item at every parish council meeting. Every month, we will provide a question for Parish Council to consider at their next meeting to facilitate discussion around Safe Ministry practices and processes.

This month's question invites us to celebrate those already championing Safe Ministry and to consider how we can build a network of support: **Who are our Safe Ministry champions in the parish who can mentor and support others to meet their Safe Ministry requirements?**

Whilst the Safe Ministry Team are always here to help, who else is available in your parish to support and encourage volunteers with the forms and training.
