Parish Council - Safe Ministry Discussion point

Safe Ministry is a shared responsibility across all areas of the Diocese – it is everyone's responsibility to ensure our places are safe for all people, especially for children and young people.

As introduced in the E-Bulletin on 5 May the National Principles for Child Safe Organisations provide a framework to guide the Diocese in ensuring safe cultures and practices are in place.



National Principle 1 states that child safety and wellbeing is embedded in organisational leadership, governance and culture. The discussion point for this month is:

How do you, both as Parish Council members and in your individual roles, help nurture and uphold a culture of safety, care, and integrity in your parish?
