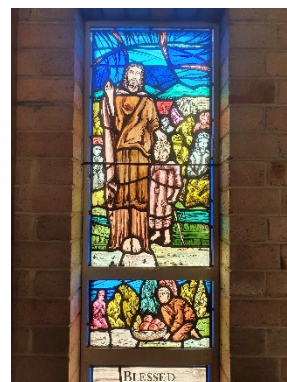
The Parish of Canning

Our Local Context

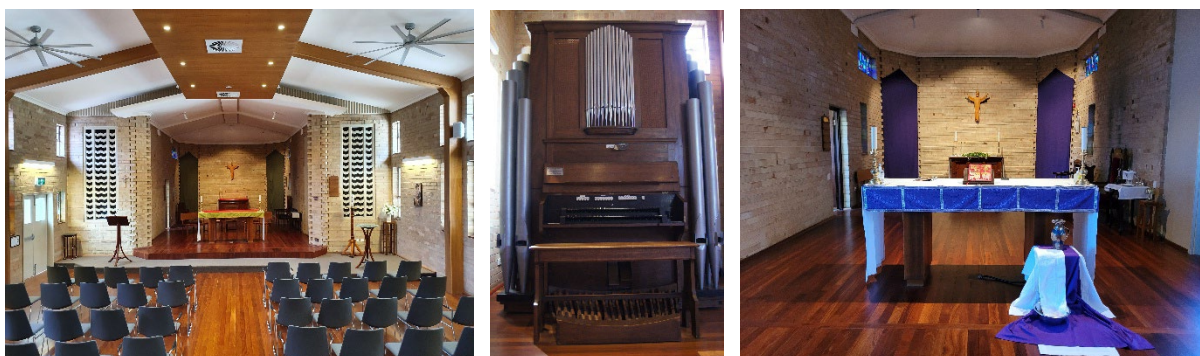
Located in the heart of Cannington, our parish enjoys meaningful partnerships with:

Our Worship and Spiritual Life

Rooted in Anglican sacramental and liturgical tradition, the Eucharist is central to our shared worship.

Our regular services are:

- 9:00am Sunday – Eucharist
- Midweek Eucharist – Wednesdays

We value thoughtful preaching, reverent worship, and a prayerful, spiritually grounded community.

Music plays an important role in our worship life. The parish choir, led by our musical director enriches congregational worship and supports the liturgical life.

Our Community Life

Parish life at Canning is relational, supportive, and enriched by cultural diversity. It includes:

- Strong networks of pastoral care and friendship
- Multicultural hospitality and celebrations
- Opportunities for spiritual formation and reflection
- A fortnightly craft and knitting group, offering creativity and companionship
