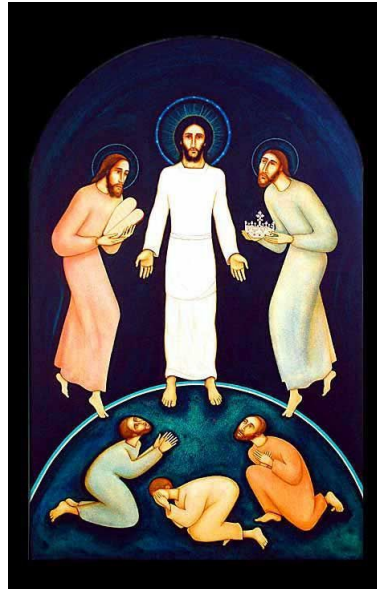

Bishop Kate will visit the Avon Valley on two occasions during August; preaching and presiding at a service at the later time of **10.00 a.m. at Quairading on Sunday, 2nd August**. On her visit to the Parish of Beverly-Brookton she will preside, preach, baptise and confirm at the single service at a **10.00 a.m. at St Mark's Church, Brookton on Sunday, 23rd August**. "Bring and share" lunches will follow each of these services.

The Feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord services on **Sundays, 2nd and 9th August** will commemorate the revelation of the eternal glory of the Second Person of the Trinity. Jesus Christ took Peter, James, and John, up on a mountain and was transfigured, his face and clothes becoming dazzlingly bright.

St Mary's Anglican Girls' School: The School's Patronal Festival, The Feast of Mary, Mother of our Lord, will be celebrated at **6.00 p.m. at Holy Trinity Church, York on Thursday, 13th August**. Those with associations with the school are most welcome to join local congregants at the service.

After the 9.30 a.m. Service at York on the 16th August the congregation will join staff of the Shire of York, the River Conservation Society members and members of the Balladong community a **Blessing of the recently completed River Trail on Holy Trinity Church land**.
