Commemoration of the Birth of John the Baptist: A service to commemorate this important event in the Christian story will take place at 3.00 p.m. on Sunday, 21st July at the Church of St John in the Wilderness, The Dale. Following the service there will be a "bring and share" afternoon tea. There will be no services at either St Mark's Church, Brookton or St Mary's Church, Beverley on that Sunday.

The first services he conducted in each of the four main centres were on Sunday, 1st August at St Faith's Church, Quairading and at Holy Trinity Church, York and on Sunday, 8th August at St Mark's Church, Brookton and St Mary's Church, Beverley.
