Annual Meetings of Enrolled Members – During June each of the parishes will conduct their annual meetings at which reports will be received and office-bearers elected. The meetings will be held at Quairading on Tuesday, 2nd June at 5.00 p.m., York on Sunday, 21st June following the 9.30 a.m. service; and Beverley-Brookton on Sunday, 28th June following the combined 10.00 a.m. service at St Mary's Church, Beverley.

Feast of St Peter & St Paul – a service to celebrate these two significant Christians leaders for which each of the churches at Gilgering and Edward's Crossing are dedicated will be held on Sunday, 21st June at 3 p.m. After the service the congregation will adjourn to a hotel in Beverley for a meal. On that Sunday there will be no services in either Brookton or Beverley.

The Coming of the Light – This Festival is central to the Christian life of Torres Strait Islanders for it commemorates the arrival of Christianity to them on 1st July, 1871.

Founder's Day, The Hale School – Given that this day is the 28th June which in 2026 is a Sunday there will be no separate services to honour the occasion, but prayers will be offered at each of the Sunday services on Sunday, 28th June.
