During March, the **Season of Lent**, the season in preparation for **Easter**, is observed. As well as Sunday services a group will meet to discuss the Anglican Board of Mission **Lenten Study “Holiday” on Mondays at 3.30 p.m. on 23rd Feb, 9th, 23rd 30th Mar, 6th, 20th Apr and 18th May**. All are welcome. Special **Way of the Cross** services will take place on the **1st and 8th May**; in these services Jesus' walk through Jerusalem to his Crucifixion is recalled.

On **Friday, 6th March** services to honour the **World Day of Prayer** - www.worlddayofprayeraustralia.org – will take place in Brookton, Quairading and York. The Order of Service has been designed by Nigerian Christian women.

The Fourth and Middle Sunday of Lent is traditionally called **Mothering Sunday**, providing an opportunity to recall with thanksgiving mothers in our lives and our communities. A **simnel cake** is baked in celebration. One of these services along with a **Blessing of the Fleece** ceremony will take place on **Sunday, 15th March at St Andrew's Church, Greenhills**. After the service attendees are invited to join in fellowship at White Gum Farm.

St Mary's Church, Beverley and Guildford Grammar School share the **Feast of the Annunciation** as their Patronal Festival. The services on **Sunday, 22nd March at Beverley and Brookton** will celebrate this special day. Meanwhile there will be a service at **Holy Trinity Church, York at 6 p.m. on 25th March**.

Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter services will take place in each of the four major centres during Holy Week and the Triduum.

This year marks the **110th anniversary of the first ANZAC Day service in York**. It was held in **Holy Trinity Church on ANAC Day, 1916**. To recognise this milestone Choral Evensong will be conducted at **5.00 p.m. on Saturday, 25th April**.
