We provide a full range of aged care including affordable housing for seniors, residential aged care, home care, day clubs, and dementia services.

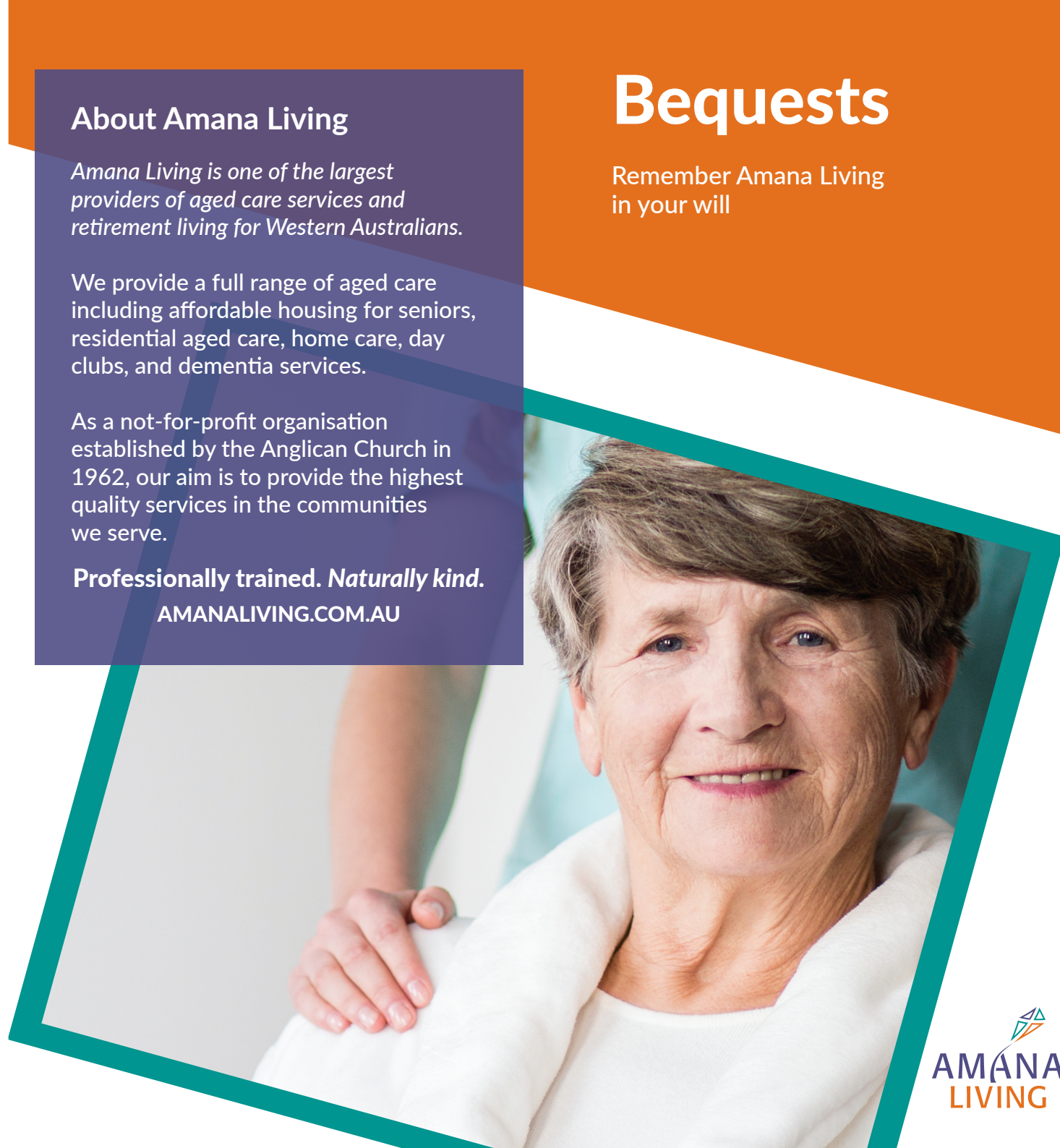
