“Deep red colour with a good tint of purple and a fragrant spice and herb aroma with a hint of dried banana, possibly from the oak. It’s full-bodied and loaded with firm tannins that come high on the back-palate and finish. A solid wine which is supple enough to enjoy now, and should respond to some cellaring. There’s good richness and concentration, and lingering persistence.”
