

### 1. What is a QED?

- ACSES has funded several randomised control trials. These are available on the ACSES Trials Registry.
- But random allocation is not always possible or practical.
- QED allow us to use existing datasets to understand the impact of an initiative.




## 2. Eligibility

- The project must be led by a Table A institution.
- Other institutions or organisations may be included as collaborators.
- Applicants can be listed on more than one proposal.
  - NOTE: Funding for more than one project will only occur in exceptional circumstances.

## 3. Priority groups & target outcomes

#### The project should:

- a. Focus on at least one of the following priority groups.
- b. Measure one or more of the following higher education outcomes



## 4. Funding available

Maximum funding available per project is \$150,000.

Personnel costs



Data



Quality assurance costs

#### Ineligible expenditure items



Overhead costs



Attendances at conferences

## 5. How to apply

A **QED Proposal Template** is available on the ACSES website for download and completion.

Three stage application process is as follows:



**STAGE 1** ACSES staff review the Proposals

STAGE 2 Equity Frontiers Grants Committee assessment

**STAGE 3** Final determination

Applicants should respond to each of the four areas in the selection criteria.

Impact potential and focus Credible Valid and reliable Experience and management

31 July 2025

**Funding announcement** 


By 29 August 2025

**Projects commence** 

By 3 November 2025

**Projects conclude**
