PROJECT SUMMARY

The Cultana Training Area is the largest training area of the Department of Defence in South Australia and is capable of supporting full combined arms exercises. It is located approximately 370km northwest of Adelaide in the Upper Spencer Gulf between Port Augusta and Whyalla. RAAF Base Edinburgh is located 25 kms north of Adelaide. It is primarily home to the Air Warfare Centre, and No. 92 Wing's AP-3C Orion and P-8A Poseidon aircraft which conduct surveillance operations throughout Australia's airspace.

SCOPE OF WORKS

Duratec was engaged by Aurecon to perform the safe removal of buildings from both Cultana Training Area and RAAF Edinburgh, including:

- Asbestos removal.
- Service isolation and disconnection.
