- Build relationships with industry stakeholders to understand how infrastructure will be impacted by severe weather events of increasing frequency and severity and what adaptive measures can be taken
- Focus on asset remediation to increase the resilience and operational life of existing structures to minimise reliance on additional infrastructure
- Ensure ecologically sustainable development opportunities and whole of life costs are considered when planning and procuring for business activities
- Trial and implement products and technologies which minimise environmental impact through lower emissions, enhanced end-of-life recyclability and lower toxicity.
- Adopt practices that increase re-use and recovery of building materials and to minimise waste across the organisation
