# MEPAU in the Mid West

## Noise Monitoring at Waitsia

MEPAU closely monitors noise levels to minimise disturbance during potentially noisy activities, including drilling and well testing (flaring), to ensure these activities cause as little impact as possible.

MEPAU is continually looking for opportunities to reduce noise levels. In recent years, MEPAU has added a 'silencer' to our temporary flare system to reduce noise. During our most recent Waitsia drilling and well testing program, we collected noise measurements to check the effectiveness of the silencer and ensure we continue to meet regulatory noise limits. Noise recordings were taken during drilling and well testing activities at Waitsia 12 and Waitsia 16 from right next to the well site to approximately 2.5 km from the well site. Background noise levels were also collected to understand ambient noise.

All noise levels recorded were within regulatory limits and when further than 500 m from the well site, most of the noise recorded was due to background noise from the weather including wind and rain.
