

# **CARNARVON BASIN**

- 17,641 sq km
- JV with Buru Energy (MinRes 75% / Buru 25%)
- Located close to
  - Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline network
  - MinRes' Onslow Iron project
- Completed 2D seismic reprocessing
- FY24/25 plan
  - 2D and 3D seismic
  - 2 exploration wells





# PERTH BASIN

- Largest acreage position 7,301 sq km (100% MinRes)
- Major natural gas discoveries


#### **Lockyer Field**

- LD1: Net pay 24m, Porosity 17%, 117 mmscf/d, <4% CO<sub>2</sub>
- L2: Excellent reservoir quality, low levels of gas
- L3: Drilling commenced, 6 weeks to total depth ~4,625m

#### North Erregulla Field

- NED1: Net pay 28m, Porosity 17%, no gas water contact
- NED1: Flow test late July 2023
- ~15km from Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline
- FY24 plan
  - 2 wells L4 development well and NE2 appraisal well
  - Feasibility study and FEED
  - Regulatory approvals
