Each club that enters is requested to provide two assessors and a patient. If there are only limited numbers of clubs, each club may need to supply two patients. This will be determined once entries have closed. Assessors should have the WA Assessor award for the Bronze Medallion as a minimum.

Champion Patrol Variation: U17 – 4 person event, minimum requirement of proficient bronze (ART knowledge recommended and advantageous). *(Note: for 2024 Aussies entry, all team members must be proficient in Advanced Resuscitation Techniques (ART) Certificate holders)*

- For any event to be contested at the 2024 SunSmart WA Surf Life Saving Championships, a minimum of three (3) individuals or teams from two (2) different clubs is required.
