



Terms and Conditions: Ultimate School Excursion to Newman Competition

Terms and conditions:

1. Promoter

The promoter of this competition is BHP Iron Ore Pty Ltd (**BHP**), operating in Western Australia.

2. Eligibility

- Entry is open to Western Australian primary and secondary school classes that attend the Resources Technology Showcase (RTS) between 17–19 August 2025.
- Each class must submit a creative video showcasing what they learned from the RTS event, specifically from the BHP stand (**Video**).
- Entries must be submitted by a teacher or school representative.
- Minimum age of student participants is 10 years; maximum age is 18 years.
- Maximum 100 attendees total, inclusive of one winning primary school class and accompanying teachers and adult supervisors; and one winning high school class and accompanying teachers and adult supervisors.

3. Entry Requirements

- Entries must be submitted by **11:59 PM AWST on 26 September 2025**.
- The Video must be original, student-created content and must not infringe any third-party rights.
- The school must ensure that each participant in the Video consents to the use of their image / content in the Video, the disclosure of the Video to BHP and the use of the Video by BHP in its internal and external communications, including social media, newsletters and promotional materials.

4. Winner Selection

- One winning primary school class and one winning high school class will be selected.
- Judging will be conducted by a panel appointed by BHP based on creativity, educational value, and alignment with BHP's values.
- The decision of the judging panel is final, and no correspondence relating to the decision will be entered into with entrants.

5. Prize Details

- A one-day excursion to BHP's Newman Operations on 13 November 2025.

- Includes:
 - Chartered return flight from Perth to Newman (same day).
 - Site tour.
 - Transportation within Newman.
 - Food and beverages.
 - BHP merchandise and PPE.

6. Scope Exclusions

- Accommodation is not provided.
- Travel insurance is not included.
- Transport to and from the Perth Airport is not included.
- Any costs incurred outside of the defined excursion scope are the sole responsibility of the school.

7. Safety and Risk Management

- A full risk management plan will be implemented in line with BHP policy and procedure.
- The school must ensure that all attendees comply with BHP's safety protocols and wear provided PPE.
- BHP will ensure that Emergency Support Officers (ESOs) are on standby.
- The school must ensure that the attendees comply with all applicable laws during the excursion.

8. Modification

BHP reserves the right to cancel, postpone, or modify the excursion for any reason, including but not limited to due to circumstances beyond its control such as:

- Extreme weather events.
- Operational disruptions.
- Government restrictions.
- Health emergencies.

9. Public Liability

BHP maintains public liability insurance for the duration of the excursion. However, schools are responsible for ensuring their own insurance coverage for travel and participation.

10. Privacy and Data Collection

- Personal information collected through competition submissions will be used solely for the purpose of administering the competition and coordinating the excursion.
- Student-generated content may be used in BHP's internal and external communications, including social media, newsletters, and promotional materials. The school must ensure that all attendees consent to the use of any student-generated content during the excursion by BHP.
- All data will be handled in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and BHP's privacy policy.

11. General Conditions

- BHP reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process or breaches these terms.
- Participation in the competition constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- These terms are governed by the laws of Western Australia.
