<b>Summary:</b>	Reminder about boat registration fee exemptions for all boats used to deliver lifesaving and emergency rescue services.
<b>Action:</b>	<b>Send a copy of the next Boat Registration Certification – First and Final Notice to the SLSWA Lifesaving team to receive a letter requesting the fee be waived. The Club is then to post this letter back to the Department of Transport along with a copy of the First and Final Notice.</b>

IRB registration with the Department of Transport (currently) incurs an annual fee of \$124.90 per boat.

All boats used to deliver lifesaving and emergency rescue services are eligible to have this fee waived by the Department of Transport. Please note, boats used for racing are not exempt.

When the Club receives the next Boat Registration Certificate – First and Final Notice, please send a copy to the SLSWA Lifesaving team ([lifesaving@slnswa.com.au](mailto:lifesaving@slnswa.com.au)) along with an email confirming the boat is used to deliver lifesaving and emergency rescue services. In reply, the SLSWA Lifesaving team will provide the Club with a letter addressed to the Department of Transport requesting the registration fee is waived. The Club must then post this letter back to the Department of Transport along with a copy of the First and Final Notice before the registration expiry date.

If accepted by the Department of Transport, the Club will then receive an updated registration certificate and registration sticker for the boat.
