Summary:	This circular is calling for an Expression of Interest from SLS clubs to run Surf Sports carnivals in the upcoming 2021/22 season.
Action:	Clubs are required to complete an online Expressions of Interest form and submit by 5pm Thursday 29 July 2021.
Appendix:	Host Club Event Checklist

There are opportunities for clubs to run interclub carnivals throughout the upcoming season. Please note that these carnivals are fully run and managed by host clubs. SLSWA provide guidelines on program and duration of event along with assistance where required as identified during discussions with host clubs. Assistance may include promotion and supply of additional gear. Entry fees are collected and kept by the club (excluding State Championship events).

In the metropolitan area, these are the set dates where Clubs could hold Surf Sport carnivals. These dates have been determined based off SLSWA's current draft planning calendar.

Little Nippers

1. A Little Nipper Carnival on 12 December 2021; and
2. A Little Nipper Carnival on either 9 or 16 January 2022.

Nippers

1. A southern metropolitan club Development Carnival on Sunday 28 November 2021 for U10 – U15;
2. A Nipper Carnival on either Sunday 5 or 13 December 2021; and
3. A Nipper Carnival on Sunday 16 January 2022.

Seniors

1. A Senior Carnival on either 6 or 7 November 2021;
2. A Senior Carnival on either 4, 5 or 12 December 2021;
3. A Senior Carnival on either 8 or 9 January 2022; and
4. A Senior Carnival on 27 February 2022.

Surf Boats

Dates are yet to be confirmed however clubs interested in hosting Surfboat carnivals can express their interest through this process.

State Championship Events

Due to the number of events SLSWA must run through the first part of 2022, SLSWA will also be seeking to outsource to clubs the running of the following events.

1. The SunSmart WA Lifesaving Championships (First Aid, Champion Patrol and Champion Lifesaver) which is scheduled for 15 and 16 January 2022.
2. The SunSmart WA Masters and Country Club Championships which is scheduled for the 5 and 6 March 2022.

Metropolitan clubs interested in running one or more of these events listed above are asked to complete this online **Expression of Interest Form**. As a guide, entry fees per athlete are priced at \$10 (Little Nipper), \$15 (Nipper) and \$20 (Senior) respectively. Club hosting fee for the State Championship events will be negotiated with the successful host club.

The **Expression of Interest Form** is required to be submitted by 5pm, Thursday 29 July 2021. After the closing date, SLSWA may need to negotiate with clubs to ensure we have a workable series of events.

A checklist, as part of this circular, **Appendix: Host Club Event Checklist**, has been designed to assist clubs in running a Surf Sports Event. Clubs may wish to review this list before committing to running an event.
