1. Rise Up Camp

2. Teamwork, Opportunity and Development (TOAD) Camp

The TOAD Camp is a development program open to U14 & U15 members (13 and 14 year old). The camp is designed to expose participants to a variety of skills and activities that will enhance and encourage their development within our organisation.

Nomination Process

Clubs are asked to nominate and rank all interested, potential participants from their club. Should a parent complete an online nomination, they are not to rank their child. In this instance we will contact the club to seek endorsement and ranking before accepting the nomination.

Announcement of Participants

All successful and unsuccessful nominations will be notified on or before the week commencing 15 November 2021.

Country Club Assistance

To assist country clubs in getting members to attend these camps, a travel subsidy will be available. These subsidies are financial assistance to get youth members to and from the camp venues. In the case of the Rise Up Camp this is Point Peron in Peron. In the case of the T.O.A.D Camp this is Ern Halliday in Hillarys. **Please note, subsidies are to be claimed via a club invoice being sent to youth@slnwa.com.au no later than 31 January 2022.**
