Champion Patrol Variation: U17 – 4 person event, minimum requirement of proficient bronze (ART knowledge recommended and advantageous). (Note: for 2026 Aussies entry, all team members must be proficient in Advanced Resuscitation Techniques (ART) Certificate holders)

- For any event to be contested at the 2025/26 Fuel To Go & Play WA Surf Life Saving Championships, a minimum of three (3) individuals or teams from two (2) different clubs is required.
- Entry Fee for the Lifesaving Championships: \$30 per competitor.
