Clubs are encouraged to use a proxy to stand in for a competitor coming from another event. A proxy must step out once the event is on the start line. **Team events will not be held up waiting for competitors to come from another area.**

Competitor award/proficiency requirements: All Nipper competitors entered must have completed a preliminary skills evaluation and those competing in water events must have completed the competition skills evaluation for their age group. It is the club's responsibility to ensure any competitor entering events have the necessary skills and fitness requirements for the event they are entering.

This program of events is to be used as a guide only and may be subject to change by event organisers. Course location, directions and lengths may be altered at the discretion of the event organiser and is determined by the conditions on the day.
