Summary:	This circular contains information on the 2026 Nipper & Youth Awards.

Introduction

This Circular relates to the 2026 Nipper & Youth Awards, scheduled for May 2026. The Nipper & Youth Awards recognises the outstanding achievements of nipper and youth members across the state. The awards that will be presented at the 2026 Awards Ceremony are summarized in the tables below, with further details on each following.

1. Nipper Surf Sports Age Champion (U10-U13)

The Surf Sports Age Champions will be determined for each gender age group based on performances at the 2026 Fuel to Go & Play WA Nipper Championships held on 21 February 2026 (Beach) and 7 - 8 March 2026 (Ocean). The winners of each gender age group will be determined by tallying the number of individual gold medals won. In the case of a tie, the determination will then be made based on the number of individual silver medals won and then individual bronze medals won. If still undetermined team medals will be taken into consideration with gold considered firstly, then silver, then bronze. Parents of winners of these awards will be notified after the Championships and the winners will be invited to the Awards Ceremony.



2. Nipper Club Achiever Award:

This award recognises the outstanding club contributions of one Nipper member (preferably an Under 13 age group member <u>but must be in U10's or above</u>) and their achievement of the outcomes in the areas of individual safety, surf awareness, lifesaving and surf sports skills as prescribed in the Woodside Nipper Program. A Club Officer needs to complete and submit the nomination form (Appendix A) by 12pm Friday 13 March 2026. Criteria for this award is outlined on Appendix A. Please note that the nomination will be used by the Development Committee to determine the **Nipper of the Year**.

3. Nipper of the Year

Each nominated Nipper Club Achiever will be considered for the Nipper of the Year, which will be determined by the Development Committee and announced at the Awards Ceremony. It is imperative therefore, that clubs ensure they clearly address the criteria for Nipper Club Achiever to give their member the best possible chance of becoming the Nipper of the Year.

4. Surf Sports Age Champions (U14 & U15)

The Surf Sports Age Champions will be determined for each gender age group in U14 & U15 based on performances at the 2026 Fuel to Go & Play WA Surf Life Saving Championships held on 28 February – 2 March 2026 (Beach & Ocean events). The winners of each gender will be determined by tallying the number of individual gold medals won. In the case of a tie, the determination will then be made based on the number of individual silver medals won and then individual bronze medals won. If still undetermined team medals will be taken into consideration with gold considered firstly, then silver, then bronze. Parents of winners of these awards will be notified after the Championships and the winners will be invited to the Awards Ceremony.

5. U14/U15 Lifesaver of the Year

This award recognises outstanding patrolling service during the 2025/26 season by a youth member. Only youth members in the U14 or U15 age group are eligible for this award. A Club Officer needs to complete and submit the nomination form (Appendix B) by 12pm Friday 13 March 2026. The Development Committee will determine the winner of this award.

6. Youth Official of the Year

This award recognises and rewards a youth member who has made an outstanding contribution to officiating during the 2025/26 season. The member must be a registered SLSWA Youth Official. The Development Committee will determine the winner, and clubs are invited to nominate one registered youth official (U14 – U17) via the nomination form (Appendix C) by 12pm Friday 13 March 2026. SLSWA can also nominate youth members for this award.

7. Youth Club Achiever Award:

This award recognises the outstanding club contributions of one youth member (Under 14 - Under 17) in the areas of lifesaving, training, leadership and surf sports. A Club Officer needs to complete and submit the nomination form (Appendix D) by 12pm Friday 13 March 2026. Criteria for this award is outlined in Appendix D. Please note that the nomination will be used by the Development Committee to determine the **Youth of the Year**.

8. Youth of the Year

Each nominated Youth Club Achiever will be considered for the Youth of the Year, which will be determined by the Development Committee and announced at the Awards Ceremony. It is imperative therefore, that clubs ensure they clearly address the criteria for Youth Club Achiever to give their member the best possible chance of becoming the Youth of the Year.



Conclusion

This is a great opportunity for clubs to recognise their outstanding Nipper and Youth members and we strongly encourage all clubs to nominate members even if they do not meet all criteria, particularly in the case of the Nipper and Youth Club Achievers. The criteria for these awards will be primarily be used to determine the Nipper and Youth of the Year. Further details of the Awards Ceremony will be provided to invited guests, finalists and winners closer to the event date.

As well as the awards outlined in this Circular there are several other awards recognising the outstanding contribution of adults to our nipper and youth programs. Details on these awards will be provided in the Awards of Excellence Circular.
