<b>Summary:</b>	This document outlines entry details for the 2025 Fuel to Go & Play WA Endurance Championships, which will be held on Saturday, 11 October 2025. All events to be held at Leighton Beach, Fremantle.
<b>Action:</b>	Clubs are to note the event date and competitive conditions for the championships.

### EVENT DATE & LOCATION

The 2025 Fuel to Go & Play WA Endurance Championships will be at Fremantle SLSC, Leighton Beach, on Saturday, 11 October 2025.

This event is proudly sponsored by Healthway, promoting the Fuel to Go & Play message.

### LIST OF EVENTS AND START TIMES

The list of events and race distances for the 2025 Fuel to Go & Play WA Endurance Championships are outlined in **Appendix 1**.

A minimum of three competitors from two clubs is required to constitute an event. As all races have all age groups starting at the same time, competitors can only contest one age group as identified at registration for that specific event, e.g., an U17 has the option to either enter as an U17 or Open, not both.

Given this option, an U17 may choose to enter for example, the U17 2km swim and the Open 3.5km board event.

Should there be less than three competitors from two clubs in a specific age category, SLSWA will advise the competitors after close of entries and afford the option of changing the category they entered.

The results will be awarded based on the category entered, e.g., if an U19 registered competitor crosses the line 1<sup>st</sup> and the first Open registered competitor crosses the line 4<sup>th</sup>, the U19 will receive a gold medal in the U19 division only. The Open competitor will receive a gold medal for the Open division and so on.

### AGE CATEGORIES

- **Nipper Gold:** U12, U13
- **Youth/Open:** U14, U15, U17, U19, Open
- **Surf Boats:** U19, U23, Open, Masters 160+
- **Masters:** 30-44, 45-59, 60+

## ENTRY FEES

- Surf Boat (U19 - Masters) \$20 per person. Note if a sweep/rower will be in both male and female races, a total of \$20 for that athlete will be charged.
- All other events - \$20 for first event entered and \$5 for each subsequent event.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.

## BRIEFINGS

**Officials and water safety:** 7.30am

**Competitors:** A safety briefing for competitors will take place 10 minutes before each starting wave.

## EVENT COURSE MAPS

The event course maps will be distributed in the coming weeks.

## ENTRY CONDITIONS

- Members and or clubs are required to enter and pay directly in the Surftec online system before close of entries on **Thursday 2 October, 11.59pm. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- For this event, Surf Boat **teams** will need to be created by the Club from the entries by **Monday 6 October, 11.59pm.**
- Competitors must be current 2025/26 surf life saving club members and be proficient.
- Age categories for these championships are taken as of 30 September 2025.
- U12 and U13 competitors must possess the competition skills evaluations. The 2024/25 evaluations are valid for this event. New members must obtain the evaluation before the event.
- U14 competitors without an SRC for this event must have an U13 competition skills evaluations from 2024/25
- U15 competitors must possess the SRC as a minimum.
- First Year U17 competitors may compete with the SRC as a minimum.
- U17, U19, Open and Masters competitors must possess the Bronze Medallion as a minimum.
- Competitors must comply with Policy 5.04 – Competition Eligibility and the Guidelines for Competition Eligibility documents. *Note: U14 age competitors do not need to fulfil patrol hour/service obligations to be eligible to compete in the Championships.*
- All competitors in water-based surf lifesaving events held by SLSWA will be required to wear a **yellow hi-viz lycra vest.**
- All competitors must have a **competition red band.** If you do not have one or have not got one from your Club prior to the Championships, you will need to purchase one on the day at the officials tent for **\$5.**

## MEDAL PRESENTATIONS

Presentation of championship medals will be held on the beach as each event has concluded.

## ENDURANCE CHAMPIONSHIPS BANNER – Total Aggregate

The Fuel to Go & Play WA Endurance Championship banner is presented to the highest point score overall. This will incorporate all results from all applicable age groups (nippers to masters).
