

Materials

- 2x A4 Paper
- 1x A3 Paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Craft Materials (we used markers)



- **1)** Get into pairs and each create a separate picture on an A4 piece of paper angled in a portrait direction. Your pictures should be completely different to one another. You will notice the optical illusion more if you use different colours to your partner.
- **2)** Cut each of your pictures up into 3 vertical strips.
- **3)** Glue alternating slices of your image and your partner's image onto your A3 sheet of paper.
- **4)** Concertina fold your page up along the lines of your cut up images.

Stand your image up on the table.
Walk around and look at your sheets from different angles.

- What does it look like from the front?
- What does it look like from the sides?
- Does the image change when you are looking up from below, and down from above?
- What is the best angle to get your eyes to see your whole images?
