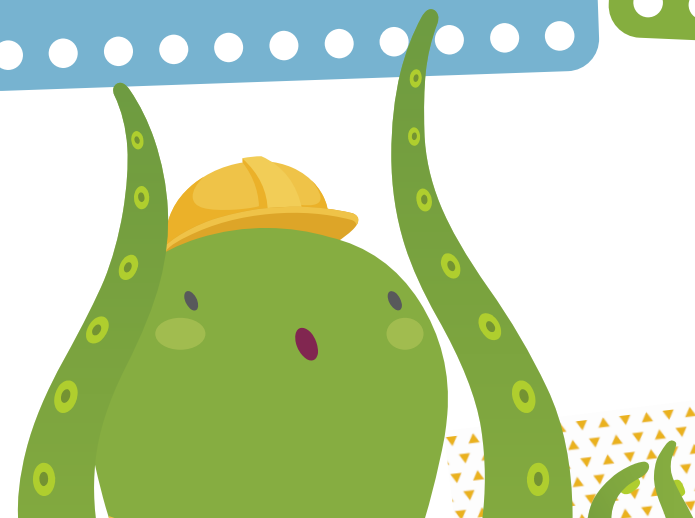

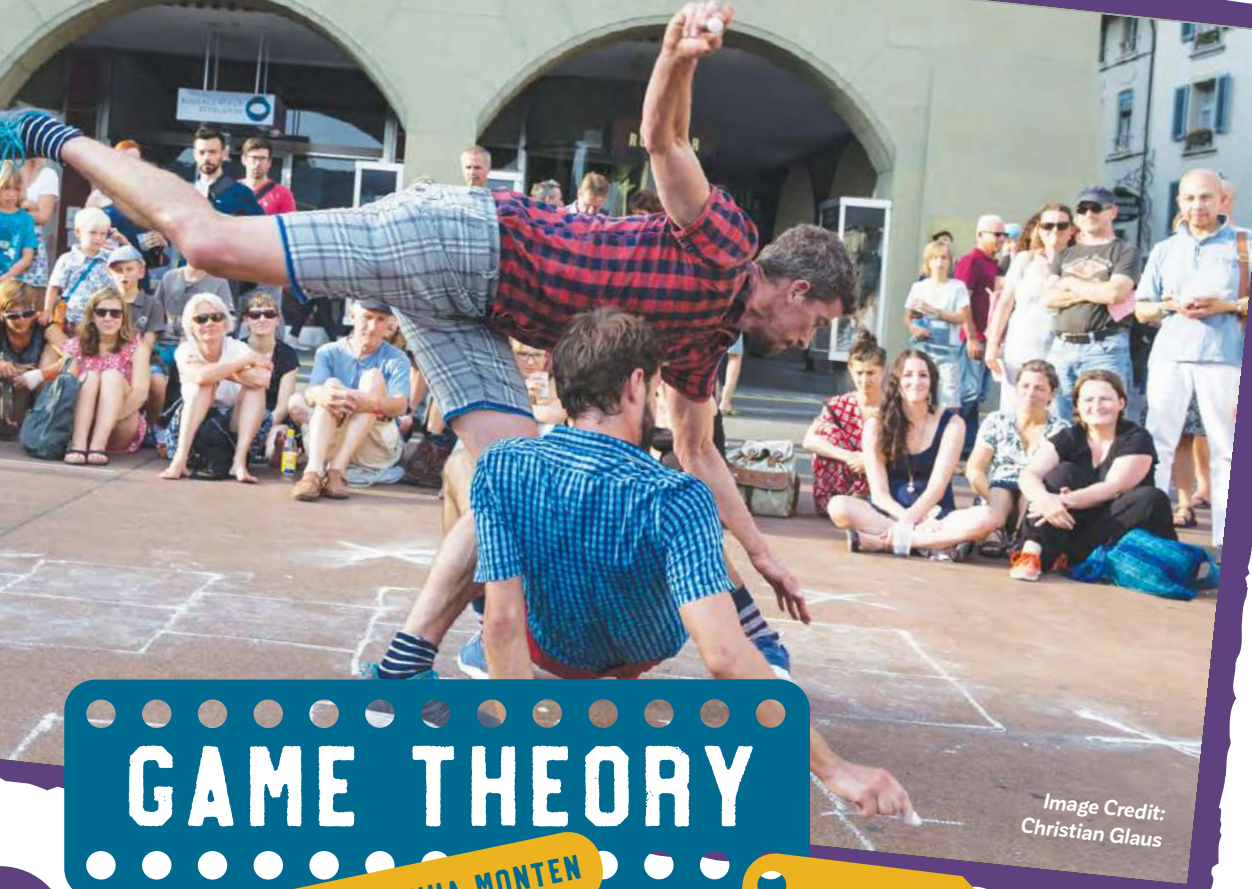

This stunning outdoor dance performance developed in Switzerland, will be performed free at the University of WA opening program and in the Perth Cultural Centre. *Game Theory* will have your bright young things dancing all the way home.



El Presidente Minusculo is a roving/audience interactive piece for children aged 5-12.

After designing a new flag and writing their presidential decree one child becomes *El Presidente Minusculo* of the Festival and is treated with all the pomp and ceremony they deserve. Their Presidential motorcade (pulled by two grown-ups in splendid regalia) winds its way through the festival grounds. With much fanfare, their decree is read aloud and their word is law... until they are overthrown by the newest *El Presidente*.
