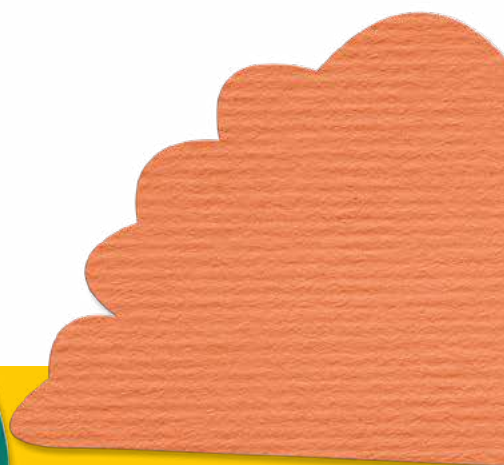
The City is thrilled to welcome families to experience some of the best theatre shows, visual arts exhibitions and contemporary dance created by artists locally and from around the world.

The AWESOME International Arts Festival for Bright Young Things is Western Australia's premier arts event specifically for families and

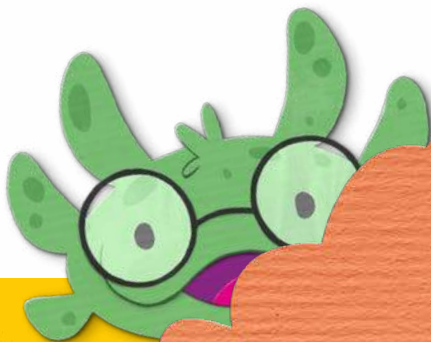
children from as young as two and is back in the October school holidays to inspire and ignite young imaginations.

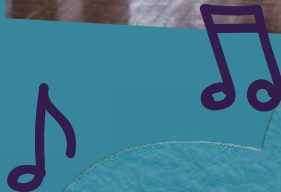

Show: Vocal adventurer, multi-instrumentalist and looping, beatboxing songwriter Mal sings his brain provoking songs using all sorts of vocal techniques, guitar, mbira, slide trumpet, trombone, chromatic harmonica and a loop recording pedal called Derek. And Kylie (who's played with Orchestra Victoria and the likes of Stevie Wonder and Barry White) provides violin and voice in a perfect balance to Mal's nuttiness. Their arrangements are intricate and playful. Imagine Einstein, Dr Seuss and Paganini making pancakes!
