| Total blackout (Audience)  The auditorium will go into total blackout at the end of the performance, and also as they lift off into space | Children invited on stage  | Distinctive smells  | Intermission/breaks  |
| Lighting level Low | Performers go into audience  | Special effects  Haze/smoke machine | Introduction  Acknowledgement to Country and reminder to turn off mobile phones. Approximately 1 minute |
| Flashing lights  | Manual activity (e.g. read, draw, paint or sing)  Writing/drawing foyer activity with support from parents/guardians | Textures  | Children need to sit in one place  |
| Loud sounds  Sounds of loud buzzer every time The Man appears and rocket lift off in certain scenes | Undertake directed movement  | Balloons  | Appropriate to make noise/move around  |
| Repetitive noises  | Participate in groups/pairs  | Characters expressing anger  The Man gets frustrated in certain scenes. However, the anger is mild and not frightening | |
| Drums  | Carers can support in participation  Parents/guardians are encouraged to assist their children in the foyer activity, only if necessary | Dialogue driven  | |
| High-pitched tones  Sounds of rocket lift off and alarms blaring in certain scenes | Children slower in movement can participate  | Props  | |
| Unexpected sounds  The sound of the buzzer will be unexpected the first time after that it can be guessed when it will come | | | |
