NOTES FOR EDUCATORS

The Dawn and Shawn books are decodable which means that they are phonetically controlled, matching our level 8 letter-sounds. Follow the steps when using these books during supported reading time.

Supporting the Reader

- 1. Read the title of the book and predict what might happen.
- 2. Read through the sounds by having the student tap and say the sounds that match the letters.
- 3. Read through the sight words. These words will appear often in the book and may have spelling that is either irregular or unknown to the reader at this stage.
- 4. Read through the word warm up words to practise decoding.
- 5. Encourage the reader to read the story. If the reader comes to a word that they may not know, it is important to encourage the blending process (sounding out and sliding the sounds together). Reread the sentence if errors are made to help with fluency and comprehension.
- Stop at each chapter and talk about the events and characters in the story. There are questions at the back.
- 7. At the end of the story discuss the plot (beginning, complication, resolution) and do a story retell.
- Lots of positive praise is recommended for struggling readers, as reading can sometimes be strenuous for some.








More to Explore

Dawn and Shawn landed on the ledge and stayed there for a while.


Dawn and Shawn sat on the ledge and came up with a plan.

Dawn landed next to the web and tried tugging at it to help get it off Shawn.


You are lucky that this is a cobweb and has no spider in it, Shawn.
