Your ALS practical assessment can be completed by a CRANAplus Educator either face-to-face or via Zoom. If a CRANAplus Educator is not available, an External Assessor (appointed by CRANAplus) will be arranged by the CRANAplus Educator.

It is your responsibility to organise the required documentation, equipment and venue for your assessment.

- Yankeur sucker and Y Suction catheter
- Magills forceps (for medical staff assessments only)
- Adult Hudson $\mathrm{O}_{2}$ mask
- Bag valve mask
- IVC's
- 10 and 20 ml syringes
