## Equipment required

- Adult Mannequin: for simulation of CPR, defibrillation and airway insertion
- Defibrillator which can be used in manual mode e.g: Zoll/Lifepack
- Defibrillator pads (adult)
- Airways: oropharyngeal, nasopharyngeal, LMA (size 3 fits most mannequins)
- Yankeur sucker and Y Suction catheter
- Magills forceps (for medical staff assessments only)
- Adult Hudson O<sub>2</sub> mask
- Bag valve mask
- IVC's
- 10 and 20ml syringes

## If available:

- Ampoules of Adrenaline, Amiodarone, 5% dextrose, n/saline
- Stethoscope, BP cuff
- IV Fluids: e.g.: n/saline
- O<sub>2</sub> sat probe
- End tidal CO<sub>2</sub> monitoring device

## For assessments via Zoom

- Computer/laptop/smart phone/tablet with working camera and Zoom (<https://zoom.us/>) which has been tested and is in working order.
