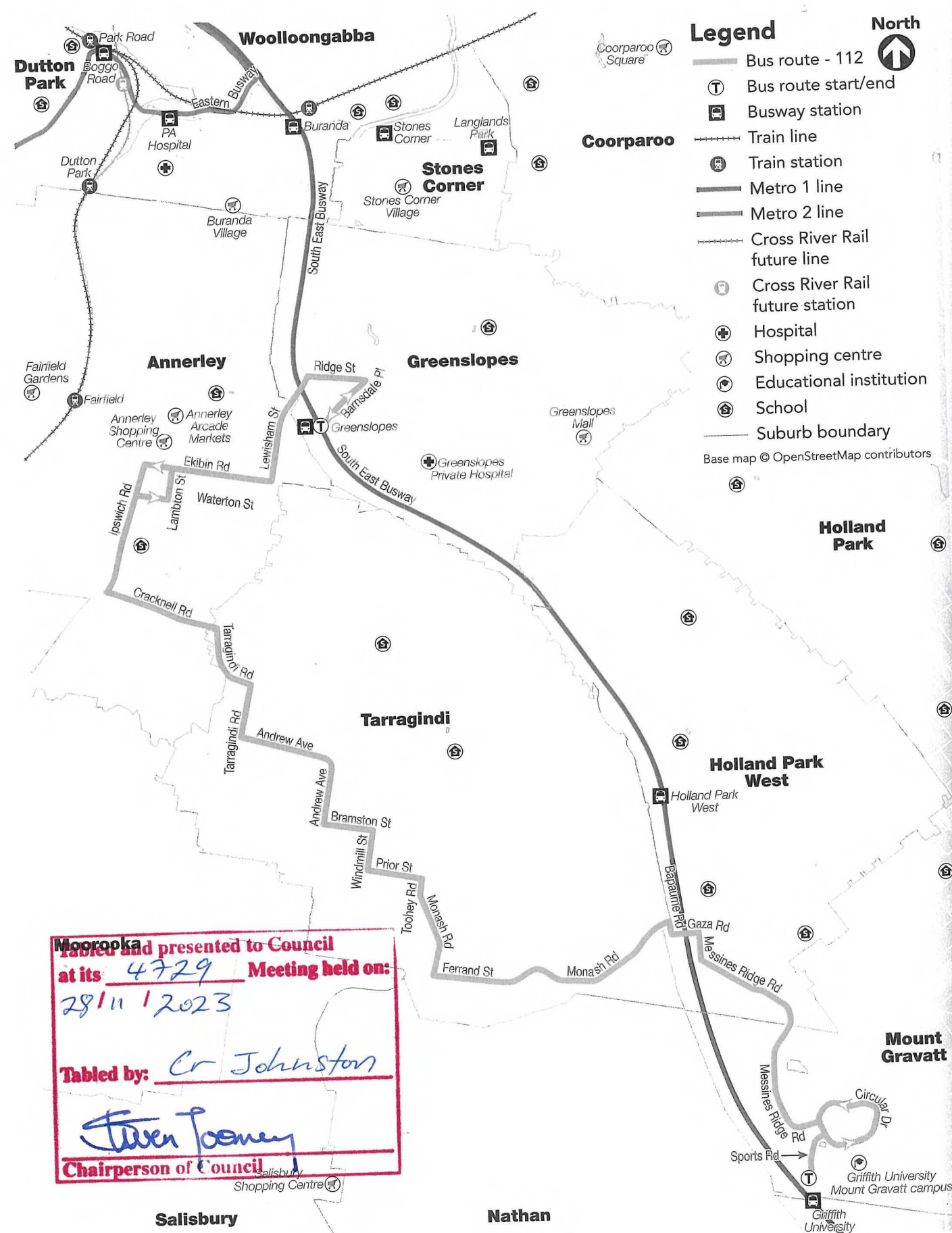

Type of service	Full-time all stops	
Route description	This service will operate between Griffith University station and Greenslopes station. This service will operate seven days a week.

What changes are being proposed and why	<p>Route 112 will be redesigned to operate between Griffith University station, Griffith University Mt Gravatt campus and Greenslopes station.</p> <p>Route 112 is proposed to incorporate trips previously serviced by Route 114 – Holland Park West to City.</p> <p>The merging of these two routes will maintain the same number of trips along the common alignment.</p> <p>Inbound to the city, Route 112 connects to M1 at Greenslopes station providing same-platform connections to the inner busway and city.</p> <p>The new route path will provide faster trips to the inner busway and city by connecting to the M1, and the opportunity to connect to more busway destinations.</p> <p>Outbound from the city, customers will transfer from M1 to Route 112 at Greenslopes station. This transfer will be at a bus stop, a short distance from the busway station.</p> <p>Suburban changes - a new route path to service Cracknell Road and Ipswich Road, between Cracknell Road and Waterton Street, provides the opportunity to connect with Annerley Road services including Route 116 – Salisbury to City.</p>	
Possible alternative services	<p>Customers travelling from Mt Gravatt and Tarragindi to the inner busway and city:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Route 112, then transfer to high-frequency M1 – Eight Mile Plains to Roma Street at Greenslopes station <p>Customers travelling from Ekibin Road East in Tarragindi to inner busway and city:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Route 113 – Mt Gravatt Central to Greenslopes station, then transfer to high-frequency M1 – Eight Mile Plains to Roma Street and busway services at Greenslopes station
