- A11. Council does not issue 'move on' orders. Under the Police Powers and Responsibilities Act 2000, a police officer has the authority to instruct individuals to 'move on' under specific conditions. Council does not pay Queensland Police Service to exercise their powers under the Act.
- Q12. Out of the total amount budgeted for the 2024-25 FY, how much was the actual spend on Pathways Out of Homelessness grants?
- A12. Approximately \$1m.
- Q13. How many complaints did Council receive regarding rough sleepers living in parks and public spaces in the 2024-25 FY?
- A13. The Contact Centre received 2,362 contacts in relation to rough sleepers in parks or public spaces in 2024-25 from the public. 11 complaints were received from Ward Offices about rough sleepers and antisocial behaviour through other channels.
