I refer to your recent decision to cut the Newcastle Train Line at Wickham, preventing trains into the Civic and Newcastle stations.

I seek further detail and clarification around factors that led to this decision and future planning, modelling and costs.

- 1. What modelling and planning for the new Wickham terminal is available to inform the public debate and comment on this issue?
- 2. Was Railcorp consulted to discuss infrastructure needs at the proposed new Wickham terminal?
- 3. What will be the total cost of this project including construction of the new terminal, construction of bus interchange, removal of existing infrastructure east of the new Wickham terminal, development of public "green corridor", modification of buses that will allow for transport of bikes, surfboards, etc, and any other building, construction and infrastructure costs?
- 4. Which Government department will have responsibility and authority during the development, planning and construction phases?
- 5. Were there any surveys or community consultation processes used to inform the decision? If so who, when and where were these conducted and who was involved?
- 6. Was there any consideration and risk assessment for the installation of more level crossings, vehicle and/or pedestrian along the line east of Wickham?
