Dear Newcastle Herald,

It is advocated in The Herald 1/10/12 that Light rail be used in Newcastle. The advocates need to do their maths in transporting people.

At 4.30pm a 1000 people need to use the rail at Newcastle, with light rail carrying some 150 people, you require 7 trains. If the gap between trains is 3 minutes it would take 21 minutes for train travel. But you need to include the time it takes to open the gates at Wickham, so to move 1000 people it would take some 35 minutes, by then you would have the 5.00pm workers finish looking for transport. Anyone who arrived at Civic at 4.30pm to cannot catch a train would not be able to board a train till about 5.30pm. You would need 7 drivers, 7 guards 7 light rail trains morning and evening.

The maths needs doing for the light rail option, it does not work.

 Newcastle Urban Renewal

I am a certificated Mechanical engineer, and not too bad at maths.
 Regarding the cutting of the rail at Wickham, I have asked for Modelling of the proposed transport system, but the Government people have only made a guess that buses running 4 minutes apart will transport people out of Newcastle to the Wickham interchange.

Since you belong to academic groups I ask that you have elementary modelling done by academics so the Government people will take notice and try to see if the submitted figures are incorrect.

I forward my figures that I argue buses do not work.

A train can carry some 400 people at time out of Newcastle on the Sydney Line. A few Minutes later a train to Maitland carries some 300 people. To transport these people by bus with the capacity of the bus being 70 odd the train has to wait till the passengers board. For busses to take the people from Newcastle to Wickham takes some 40 minutes to pick up the last person waiting in Newcastle, so extra time taking getting out of Newcastle is some hour or so before the same train can leave Wickham. It is noted since all the buses are full for at least some 40 minutes people waiting at Civic to catch a bus would have to an some hour or so before there is a vacate spot to catch a bus to Wickham. This is not a good plan since some 3000 students from the Newcastle University need be also transported from Civic

The cutting of the line is supposed to be a planned thing, so these figures to show how the above situation does not occur should be available. The plan, if there is one, should show how many platforms will be Wickham so trains can have planned movements. I guess there is no detailed plan, so costs cannot be done at this stage. I guess the \$120 Million is a hope fund rather than a planned budget to get the project of making Wickham a termination station

I trust you could get an academic to do mathematical modelling to show buses do not work
