I have been away for the last month and only returned yesterday so have not had a lot of time to respond to this plan. Luckily my neighbours alerted me to it as I wouldn't have seen it otherwise. I would like to object to the proposal to zone this area for flats because I do not believe that the suburb has 'outlived its zoning or use'. Even if the station is built it does not mean that the area is suitable for urban consolidation under the Government's own planning policy (SEPP 32). There are other stations without high-rise and many other places where high-rise is suitable.

I am building a house in Robert Rd Cherrybrook which will not be finished until Christmas. I did not choose to build here to be surrounded by 3-6 storey flats and my new home cannot be considered redundant if it isn't even finished.
