### 1 Name of Policy

#### 129B Definitions

In this Division:

### 129C State sport and recreation centres

(1) Development for the following purposes may be carried out by or on behalf of the Department of Education and Communities, or by or on behalf of the State Sporting Venues Authority, with consent on land comprising a State Sport and Recreation Centre:

Agriculture, animal boarding or training establishments, boat launching ramps, boat sheds, camping grounds, caravan parks, community facilities, eco-tourist facilities, educational establishments, entertainment facilities, food and drink premises, function centres, information and education facilities, kiosks, markets, medical centres, public administration buildings, recreation facilities (indoor), recreation facilities (major), recreation facilities (outdoor), tourist and visitor accommodation, water recreation structures

(2) This clause does not require development consent for the carrying out of any development if that development could, but for this clause, be carried out without development consent.
