In response to the Amended Draft Sutherland Shire Local Environmental Plan 2013, and as land owners close to the Miranda Centre **Environmental Plan 2013**, and **y**,

, we would like to ask the Council to consider allowing higher floor space density from 1.5-1 to 2-1 and extra height from 20 metres (6 storeys) to 25 metres (7-8 storeys).

We hope that, in considering our request, the Council will take into account the following:

- In particular, the land blocks between the railway line and Urunga Parade are large and there is open space at the rear (railway line). The blocks are also facing north at the front (no shadowing);
- Area 8, bound by Urunga Parade, Kingsway and west Gurrier Ave, has floor space density of 2-1 and height of 25 metres;
- Area 5 on the west side of the Miranda Centre, bound by Kingsway, the F6 road reservation and the railway line, and traversed by University Road, also has floor space density of 2-1 and height of 25 metres;
- In your Miranda Centre report, you state: "Outside the centre zone, the area south of the Kingsway is proposed as a new residential flat precinct. The precinct is bordered by the railway line and the Kingsway, which separate the precinct from adjacent low density residential uses. The proposal is for a permissible height of 25m (7-8 storeys) and FSR 2:1."
