I DISAGREE STRONGLY WITH THE SNEAKY INSERT IN WHICH PEOPLE WHO LIVE IN THE AFFECTED AREA HAVE NO IDEA ON WHAT IS CURRENTLY PROPOSED.

THERE IS ACRES OF GREEN ZONE BETWEEN INGLEBURN AND MACQUARIE FIELDS WHICH IS UNDER UTILISED AND COUNCIL STRUGGLES TO MAINTAIN WHAT IS ALREADY THERE, SO WHY DO WE NEED MORE.
