As a landowner I have been put on standby and am fed up with the government's planning policies since as long as I can remember. I've been unable subdivide my land because Appin will be needed for Sydney's expansion. Now this latest investigation just seems to be a repeat of the past.

Appin is needed but not until 2036???

I pay high land rates just because of the value of the land and because one day the land might be used for potential urban expansion. Today, I can't use it for agriculture and I just can't compete with the larger farms west of the mountains.

Your study states that Appin village can be protected and I will support this but this should not mean that the whole region is sterilised. West Appin isn't even visible from the village because it's separated by bushland.

The community will no doubt support well planned growth that protects the bushland and animal habitats and will support growth if it results in real improvements to our roads especially Appin Rd.
