Dear Sir

I am writing to register my objection to your plans for urban consolidation around the Castle Hill Showground Road Precinct which has been planned to tie in with the North-West Rail link.

Your desire to crowd thousands of people into this area to make the rail road profitable is ill-judged and ill-conceived. Your plans depict an urban jungle in what used to be the Garden Shire.

With people come cars. Not everyone can get to work using rail. Plenty of workers have to carry their tools and equipment with them. Our streets are already pushed to breaking point in peak hour. What on earth is going to happen when thousands more live in the area?

The M7 leads onto the Industrial Park at NorWest Boulevard, and already drivers are caught in traffic jams in peak hour for more than an hour. With your proposed intense build-up of population the situation will be untenable. There are only 2 main roads, Windsor Road and Old Northern Road, which are going to be choked with traffic as a result of the multi-storied residential tower blocks around Castle Towers.

As usual your government has put little thought into traffic flow as you rush into urban consolidation. You are ruining what was a pleasant suburb.
