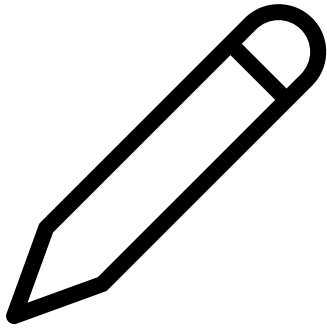

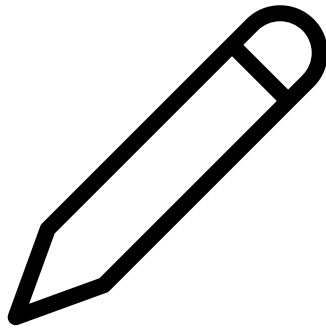
The Central Coast is an amazing region with many opportunities for its residents that were not possible many years ago. Children now have greater access to things such as the Central Coast Mariners, Indoor skate parks and Treetops adventure park all of which make it a highly desirable place to live and work.

1. I believe that with the pending council merger Tuggerah should be the regions capital as it is centrally located and close to the M1. Gosford is outdated and a ghost town at the best of times. Tuggerah has a variety of new businesses and buildings and looks the part of a regional capital. This would also assist in preventing any power struggle between the 2 councils and the Gosford Council building could be sold as part of the towns redevelopment.
2. Roads / traffic are a major concern for central coast residents with simple journeys taking far too long. It is quicker now to get from Gosford to Wyong then it is from Berkeley Vale to Wyong in the afternoon peak. Roads to need to built / upgraded before housing estates are commenced and before the existing roads are chocked with the increased population
3. Employment opportunities are a must to keep residents on the coast and not traveling north/ south along the M1. As a region the Central Coast needs to capitalise on its major strength which is its location - central to both Sydney and Newcastle. Greater emphasis on investment and incentives to bring that investment is crucial to ensure that we have the employment for our residents into the future.
4. Recreational infrastructure needs to be updated / improved particularly around the Wyong area. With the new and predicted housing estates in Wadalba / Warnervale cycleways, parks, playgrounds need investing in to ensure that they are adequate for the increased population. The western side of Tuggerah Lake would benefit from a cycleway around the foreshore similar to the eastern side.
5. Better consideration for people with disabilities needs to be undertaken when planning any new infrastructure to ensure we have a fully inclusive society for all.
6. Parking - needs to be addressed for all future planning. Off street parking is a must for all units / apartments as well as better on road parking at sporting fields, main streets, shopping centres and tourism destinations. It is hard enough for locals to park let alone during tourist season.
7. Regional events - sporting, cultural and entertainment events should be capitalised on to encourage tourism to the Coast.



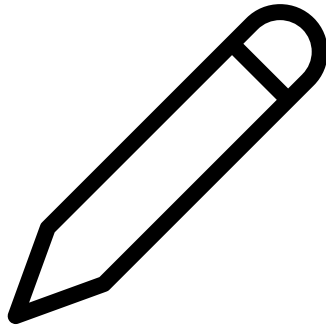

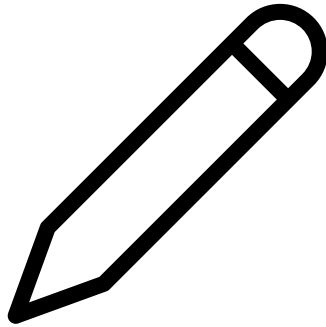

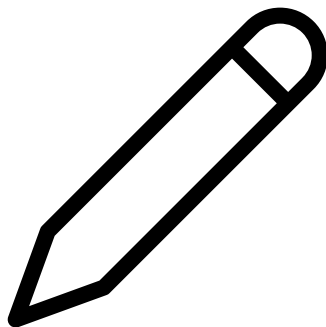
