

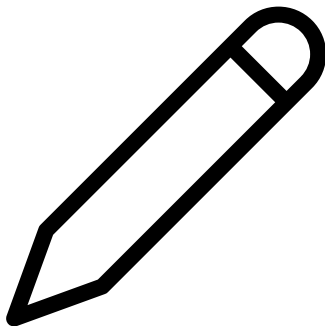

I want to make clear my position that the fertile land , natural bushland and precious water of the Mountains District needs to be protected in this Central Coast Regional Plan. Viewing the map on Page 47 causes me great concern as most of our area is marked as "identified Mineral Resource" or "Potential Mineral Resource". I do not want the land to be used for mining. In fact, any further mining on the Mountains District, and on the Central Coast, should be ruled out and the Regional Plan should clearly articulate this fact. The Plan should sustain and support expansion of food production in the Mountains District that has such temperate climate and an abundance of water. We are also situated close to both Sydney and Newcastle so transport is easier. The Plan needs to ensure the protection of water including both surface and groundwater. This is essential if the proposed expanding population is to be catered for. The Mountains District is unique in so many ways and needs to be preserved for the future, not destroyed for short term profit.

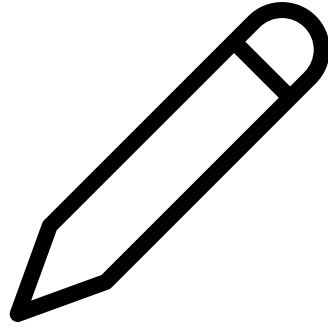
