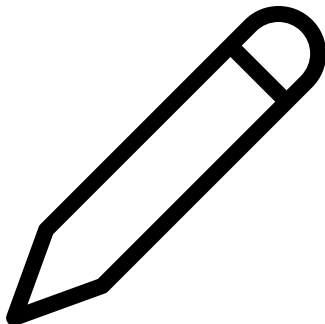
It would seem to most intelligent people that coal mining is in steep decline. The World is moving towards sustainable clean energy, whether we believe it or not.

You can't eat coal - or money - PLEASE LISTEN TO THE VOICE OF THE PEOPLE.



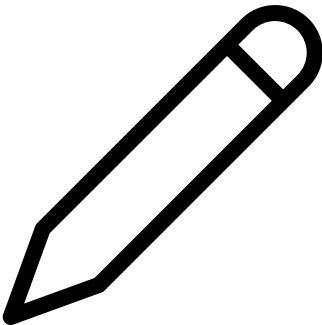
